The Police Treatment Centres is a registered police charity which provides residential treatment, support & recuperation, including intensive, police-specific, physiotherapy and rehabilitation, and treatment and counselling for psychological issues for injured and ill police officers and retired officers at rehabilitation centres in Harrogate or Auchterarder.

With effect from 14th February 2013 a special arrangement is in place whereby the PTC offers new recruits a 12 month donation free period provided that they sign up to donate to the charity during their first month of service.
