The St George's Police Children Trust is a registered charity which aims to support Police families by helping to ease the financial pressures of bringing up children in the face of life changing circumstances.

These circumstances could involve the loss of either parent (whether or not they are a Serving or Retired Police Officer) or the Police Officer parent being unable to earn an income due to illness or injury, sustained on or off duty. Financial support is provided by the Trust throughout the child/young person's school years and in many cases, into further education. More than 300 children are supported every year and more than half a million pounds is distributed to these families.
